<sup>3</sup>Therefore I want you to understand that no one speaking by the Spirit of God ever says "Let Jesus be cursed!" and no one can say "Jesus is Lord" except by the Holy Spirit.



## GOSPEL: John 2:1-11

The holy gospel according to John.

### Glory to you, O Lord.

<sup>1</sup>On the third day there was a wedding in Cana of Galilee, and the mother of Jesus was there. <sup>2</sup>Jesus and his disciples had also been invited to the wedding. <sup>3</sup>When the wine gave out, the mother of Jesus said to him, “They have no wine.” <sup>4</sup>And Jesus said to her, “Woman, what concern is that to you and to me? My hour has not yet come.” <sup>5</sup>His mother said to the servants, “Do whatever he tells you.” <sup>6</sup>Now standing there were six stone water jars for the Jewish rites of purification, each holding twenty or thirty gallons. <sup>7</sup>Jesus said to them, “Fill the jars with water.” And they filled them up to the brim. <sup>8</sup>He said to them, “Now draw some out, and take it to the chief steward.” So they took it. <sup>9</sup>When the steward tasted the water that had become wine, and did not know where it came from (though the servants who had drawn the water knew), the steward called the bridegroom <sup>10</sup>and said to him, “Everyone serves the good wine first, and then the inferior wine after the guests have become drunk. But you have kept the good wine until now.” <sup>11</sup>Jesus did this, the first of his signs, in Cana of Galilee, and revealed his glory; and his disciples believed in him.

## SERMON

### HYMN OF THE DAY *OCEANS (MY FAITH WILL STAND)*

### Installation of a Pastor

#### Presentation.

P: Having been authorized by the church to install The Rev. Dr. Denise Arnold our co-worker in the gospel, as pastor I now ask for certification of this call.

Congregation Representative Council President Allan Erickson: After prayerful deliberation, we, of Gloria Dei Lutheran Church have called Denise Arnold as pastor. I present her and this letter certifying the call.

#### Address and Questions

*The presider reads from scripture.*

P: Pastor Denise, in the presence of this assembly will you commit yourself to this new trust and responsibility, in the confidence that it comes from God through the call of the church? If so, please respond, “I will and I ask God to help me”

Will you preach and teach in accordance with the holy scriptures and with the confessions of the Lutheran church? Will you carry out this ministry in harmony with the constitutions of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America?

Will you be diligent in your study of the holy scriptures and in your use of the means of grace? Will you love, serve, and pray for God’s people, nourish them with the word and sacraments, and lead them by your own example in faithful service and holy living? **response**

Will you give faithful witness in the world, that God's love may be known in all that you do? **response**

P: Almighty God, who has given you the will to do these things, graciously give you the strength and compassion to perform them.

P: People of God, will you receive Pastor Denise as a messenger of Jesus Christ sent to serve all people with the gospel of hope and salvation? Will you regard her as a servant of Christ and a steward of the mysteries of God?

**Congregation: We will, and we ask God to help us.**  
Will you pray for her, help and honor her for her work's sake, and in all things strive to live together in the peace and unity of Christ?

**Congregation: We will, and we ask God to help us.**

P: Pastor Denise, the office of Pastor is now committed to you in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

**Blessing** (*pastor may kneel*)

P: The God of peace, who brought again from the dead our Lord Jesus,  
the great shepherd of the sheep, by the blood of the eternal covenant,  
make you complete in everything good so that you may do God's will,  
working in you that which is pleasing in God's sight;  
through Jesus Christ, to whom be the glory forever and ever.

You have been called to be among us to baptize, to teach, and to forgive sins.

Congregational Representative (at the place of preaching)  
Jane Vaughn: You have been called to be among us to proclaim the good news.

Congregational Representative (at the table) Candace Kolberg: You have been called to be among us to preside at the Lord's supper.

P: People of God, I present to you Pastor Denise Arnold, your Pastor. Let us welcome her in the name of Christ.

**CREED**

**I believe in God, the Father almighty,
